# THE POWER of the Fund for Buhler

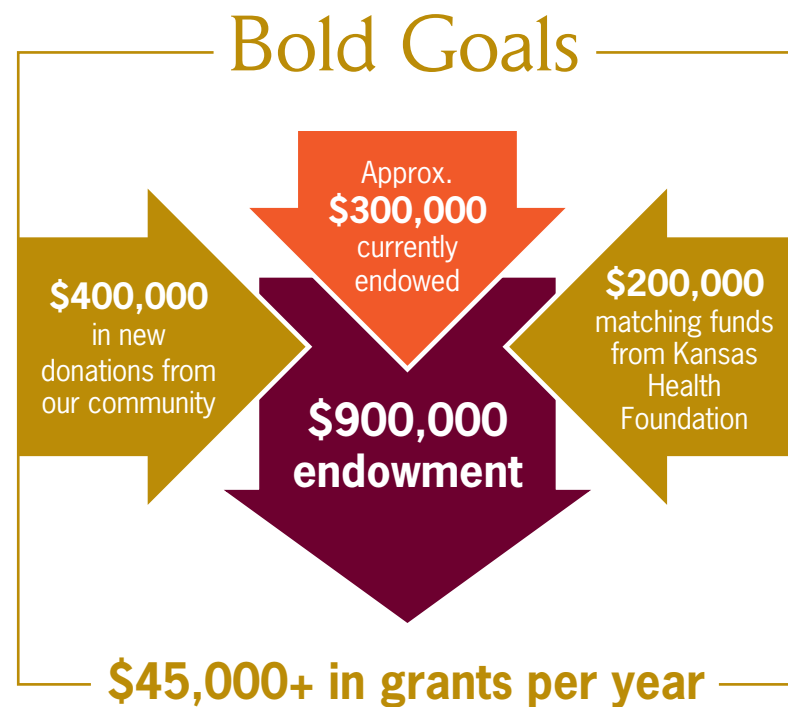
Here in Buhler, we're passionate about creating a thriving community, and the Fund for Buhler is a driving force. This pool of unrestricted funds is a "community savings account" that allows us to address needs and opportunities as they arise in our community.

Over the past 5 years, we've raised over \$200,000 for this fund, giving \$11,250 back into the community in grants.

## Our opportunity: \$200,000 in matching funds

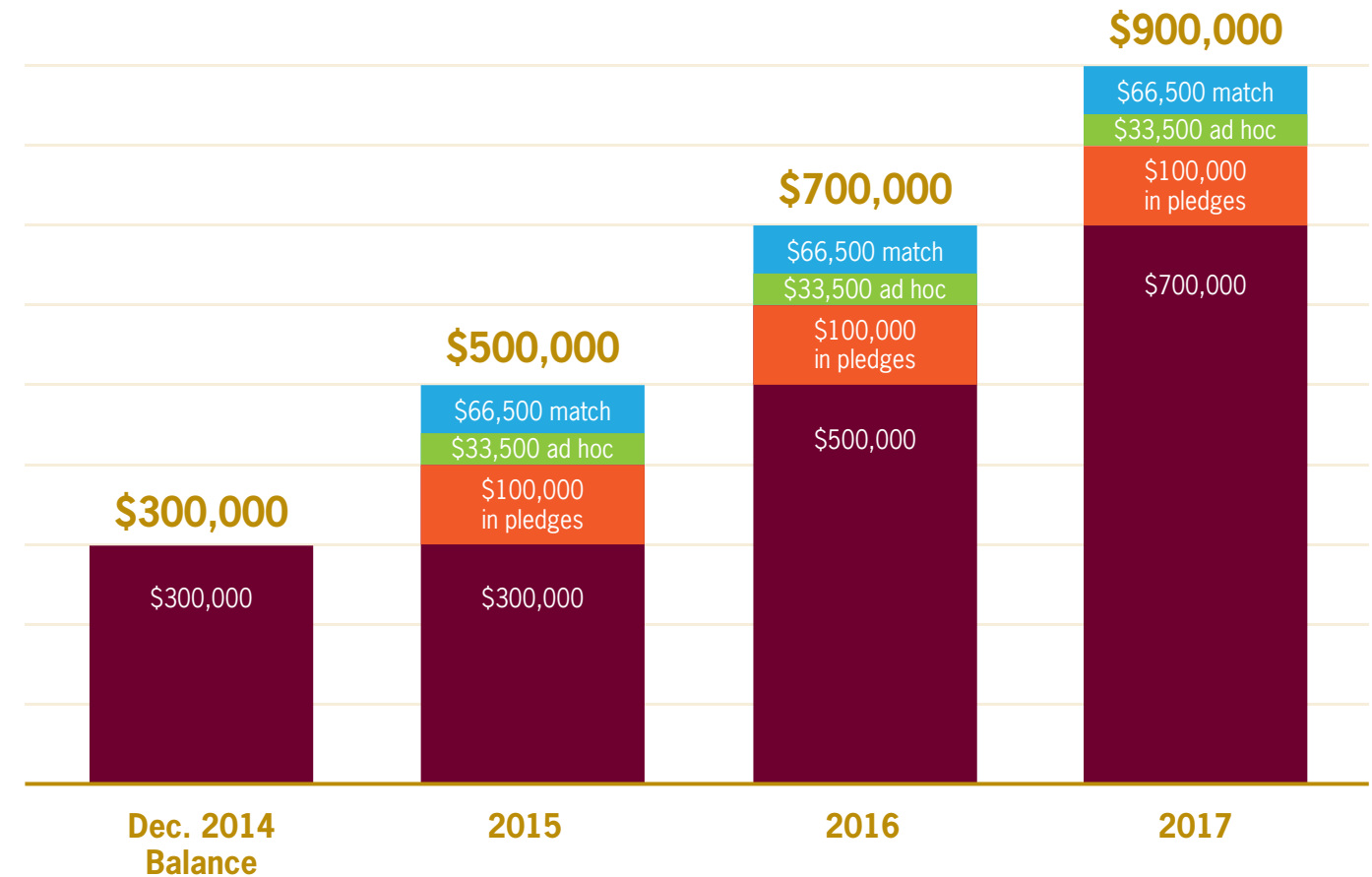
Right now we have a unique chance to capture matching funds from the Kansas Health Foundation (KHF). For every dollar donated to the Fund for Buhler or Buhler Public Health Fund through the end of 2017, KHF will match \$.50. This means the Foundation can earn an additional \$200,000 by the end of 2017 if we reach our goal of \$400,000 in donations from our community. Per KHF rules, matching funds will be divided equally between two special funds—our operating endowment, and our health endowment.

Adding this to our current endowment balance, we will have the ability to award \$45,000+ in grants each year. Imagine the power of these funds to improve our community!



## We need your pledge

Raising \$400,000 in three years is no small task. To reach this major milestone, we're asking community members to make a three-year commitment to help us reach \$100,000 in total pledges for each of the next three years. We're hopeful the final \$100,000 will come through unplanned donations.



## Giving can take almost any form
